

Silent Auction Instructions for Buyers

All Buyers

Please check with the auction desk.

We need up-to-date registration information.

- **Do not touch the items** without permission from an auction administrator. Some items are fragile and others are "white glove only," so you should not touch them.
- You must bid at least one dollar more than the last listed bid.
- Write legibly. If your **Registration #** or **Bid Amount** is not clear, your bid will be nullified and the previous bid will be re-instated. If you need assistance, ask an auction staff member.
- If you see a problem with the Bid Card or you make a mistake making your bid, do not correct yourself. You must get an auction administrator to make the change and initial it.
- Be sure your bid can be read on all three copies of the bid card.
- At the closing of the auction on Saturday:
 - There is usually a frenzy of bidding. No unruly behavior will be tolerated.
 - If you are still writing on the Bid Card when the auction closes, your bid will be nullified. Your hands must be in the air, away from the tables when the end of the auction is announced.
- Validity of final bids is reserved to the auction administration.
- Sales tax of six percent (6%) will be added to all final bids.
- There are no refunds for any reason. You are buying items "as-is."
